## Message From The Registrar of Voters' Office

San Joaquin County voters participated in the California statewide special election held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025.

Voters across the state cast ballots on Proposition 50, a constitutional measure related to congressional redistricting.

The election was conducted smoothly, thanks to the dedicated work of San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters staff and poll workers.

Following the election, the Registrar of Voters completed the official vote count and review process, concluding the canvass period on December 2, 2025.

The certified results were submitted to the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors and transmitted to the California Secretary of State, as required by state law.

Final election results were made available for public review on both the Registrar of Voters' and the Secretary of State's websites.

With the certification process complete, the 2025 Statewide Special Election results are final, marking another successful and transparent election for San Joaquin County voters.
