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Accepting Applications for Paramedic Preceptor Authorization July 1, 2018 – July 31, 2018

Who should apply?

Any paramedic that wishes to become a preceptor and has met the following requirements:

1. Minimum of three (3) years full-time experience as an accredited paramedic in San Joaquin County.
2. Paramedic licensure/accreditation is in good standing.
3. Be currently employed by an approved San Joaquin County ALS emergency ambulance provider or ALS public safety provider.
4. No pending disciplinary or clinical actions against accreditation, licensure, or employment.
5. No disciplinary or clinical actions against accreditation or licensure in the past 24 months.

Submit the application to the EMS Agency with a letter of recommendation from your ALS employer verifying that you are in good standing with that employer and that employer intends to use you as a paramedic preceptor.

Application process:

All qualified applicants will be scheduled to appear before a peer review oral board in August or September. Applicants recommended from the peer review board must successfully complete the San Joaquin County EMS Agency Paramedic Preceptor Training course (TBA), which includes passing a written exam.

Paramedic Preceptor Authorization will be granted for a four (4) year term; with maintenance requirements (see EMS Policy No. 2570 Paramedic Preceptor Authorization).

NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
