WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- All Growers, Private Applicators and other License Holders

WHY YOU SHOULD ATTEND?

- Earn continuing education (CE) hours for grower certification and other license holders.
- Receive an update and a review of pesticide laws and regulations.

WHO IS RENEWING PRIVATE APPLICATOR CARD FOR COMING YEAR?

- Growers with last names that start in the section of the alphabet **I - Q**.
Card renewal is needed to obtain Restricted Material Permits in 2017.

Growers renewing with CE hours must apply for renewal by April 1, 2017 or take the exam after that date.

HOW TO RENEW PRIVATE APPLICATOR CARD

- **CE HOURS METHOD:** Need a total of 6 CE Hours (2 hours must be Laws & Regulations)
- **EXAM METHOD:** Take a PASS/FAIL Exam
